The Town of Livingston is now offering a public Wi-Fi "hot spot" for access to the internet via laptops as well as web-enabled devices such as cellphones and tablets. There are a few important rules that users must follow in order to access the public hot spots, which include:

- Requiring users who drive to the town hall, to remain in their vehicles for the duration of internet usage.
- Requiring users who walk or take public transportation to the town hall, to
 practices social distancing and to remain at least six feet away from others and
 urging them to wear a mask or a mouth/nose covering.
- To access to the public hot spots, click the Wi-Fi icon on the web-enabled device or press its corresponding button to open the Wi-Fi application. On a Windows laptop, this function is typically located on the taskbar or "system tray" along the bottom right of the screen. On a Mac laptop, this function is typically located on the menu bar along the top right of the screen. Select "Livingston-Public" or "Livingston-Public-5G" to connect.
