### Major Accomplishments

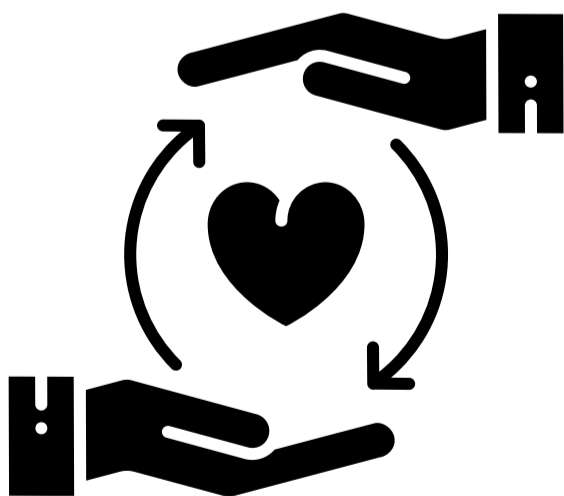
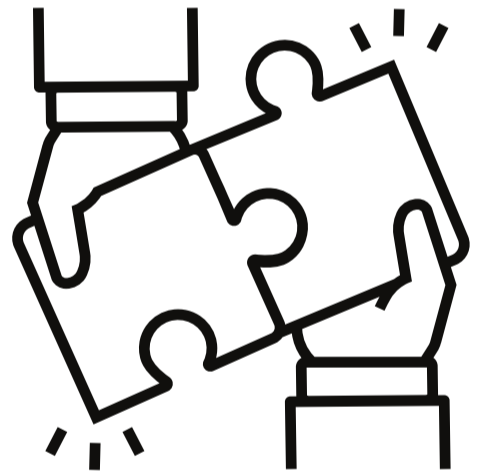
- Sponsored a summer reading program for the town's summer camp participants

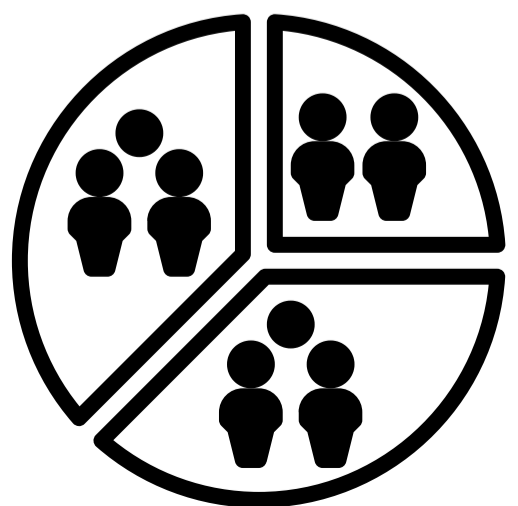
